This Indenture made and entered into this 10th day of October 1908 by and between Mattie Howard and Jeff Hagyrie and Hiram B. Howard, the guardian of the county of Wagoner, parties of the first part, and Mose Chickahom of the same place, party of the second part, witnesses: That whereas Fannie Chickahom departed this life July 4th 1901, intestate, leaving Mose Chickahom, her husband, Mattie Howard, her half sister and Jeff Hagyrie her half brother, her heirs at law, who are full blood Indians, and at the time of her death aforesaid, the said Fannie Chickahom was seized and possessed in fee simple title of the following described real estate situated in Indian County State of Oklahoma, to wit: the southwest 1/4 of section 24 in township 18 range 12 east containing 100 acres. And whereas, the above parties are desirous to partition between themselves the above described real estate. And whereas, said above mentioned parties have come to an agreement in the partition of said between themselves satisfactory to each, and also each of them now desires to carry such agreement into effect and that off to each of said parties aforesaid his proportional share of said real estate, it is agreed by and between said heirs, each with the other, as follows: That said Jeff Hagyrie take 53 and 1/3 acres off of the east side of said above described Land 100 rods long from north to south and 53 and 1/3
