General Warranty Deed

This Indenture, made this twelfth day of November, A.D. 1907, between James D. Capron, Junior, a single man of the City of St. Louis, in the State of Missouri, party of the first part, and Harry J. Hunt of Brighton, Illinois, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred ten \$100.00 Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents Grant, Bargain Sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, to wit:

All of lots Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Block Forty-two (42) of West Tulsa Addition, a subdivision of the east half of the North West quarter of Section Fourteen Township Nineteen, North Range Twelve East, according to the amended plat thereof, recorded in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and Ex officio Recorder of Tulsa, Indian Territory in book 2, page 639.

To Have and to hold the same together with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever, And the said party of the first part for himself, his heirs
