Twenty (20) head of cows, all with spring calves \$25.00 \$500.00
Ten (10) head of 2-yr- old heifers @ \$15. 150.00
Six head of Paines @ \$25.00 150.00

All above are branded PR on right hips, except one gray, horse, about 15 years old, which is branded 5 on right shoulder and hips, named "Chief".
Two (2) work horses, weight 1000# each, named Charley and Joe, chestnut sorrel, one branded L on left shoulder, the other has indistinct brand on left hip 125.00

One mare 100.00
One buggy full bearing with tire, in use, nearly 100.00
One set double buggy harness 30.00
One two horse wagon, Moline make, fairly well worn, and one set double wagon harness 30.00
