On the District Court in and for the Second Judicial District of Alabama, last the application of David Allston for rights of majority.

Decree

This matter came on to be heard before me, J. L. Brown, Judge of the District Court in and for Poplar County, State of Alabama, this the 22nd day of October 1905, upon the application and petition of David Allston, by himself, friend Susan Allston, to have their rights of majority conferred upon said David Allston a minor, and it appearing to the Court that due and legal notice of this application has been given for two consecutive weeks prior to the presenting of this petition in a newspaper printed in said county and state, and the Court having heard evidence in open Court, finds that said petitioner is of the age of nineteen years, that he is of sound mind and fully able and competent to transact his own affairs, and that the interests of said petitioner will be materially promoted by granting the prayer of said petition, and that said David Allston has been an actual resident of this state right preceding the filing of this petition, and is at present a resident of Poplar County.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed, by the Court in pursuance of the authority conferred by Sec. 2533 Stat. 1903, that the rights of majority concerning said David Allston and the same are hereby conferred upon the said David Allston, and said David Allston is hereby authorized and empowered to transact business in general with the same effect as if such business were transacted by a person over the age of majority.
