H. Morgan shall have over to me the residue of all money so received.

All former Orders of attorney, relative to the said business, intended to pay said debt and attorney, D. H. Morgan, and I forward, we hereby revoke, and this Green of attorney is intended to supersede any bond and seal on that the day of November, 1899.
