

is entitled and entitled my true and lawful  
heirs with all the power that I now might  
or could have, or may hereafter have in regard to  
the said premises described, or that I might in  
any way exercise or not exercise together

that out of the profits arising from the  
sale of the premises in due and lawful manner  
payable of the same, after deducting all the  
reasonable and legitimate expenses including taxes,  
insurance, assessments, and reasonable attorney's  
fees, that may accrue, shall retain any balance  
sum equal to one (1/3) third of all net profits  
as the reasonable pay for services rendered, one half  
of the balance in the said said said said  
Benny Hill, the beneficiary herein, or some one duly  
appointed by him, for his proper use and benefit, the  
remainder is to be kept for support and support  
to my order, but is not otherwise withdrawn it  
shall be assigned a permanent fund to be
