Preamble Contract

This agreement made and entered into this 12th day of November, 1908,
by and between Marshall of Ames, Oklahoma of part of the first part and
William T. Taylor of Claremore, Oklahoma of part of the second part.
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of eight
hundred dollars in hand paid at and before the delivery of these
presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the
first part has granted, leased and conveyed and do hereby grant, lease and
convey unto the party of the second
part all here and assigns, for agricultural purposes only, for the
rental term of five years from and after this date, the following
described lands situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
N. 6 1/4 of NW 1/4 and 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of section
twenty seven (27) and NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4
of section thirty five (35) all in Township Twenty one (21)
North Range Thirties (3) east of the Indian Meridian.
And the said party of the second part he to have the
right to back out said lands and put them in a crop
