

same for his services the balance less $3\frac{1}{2}\%$ to be kept subject to my order, shall be invested for the proper use of the beneficiary herein, limited only by such laws as may be in force at such time regarding free blood Indians. In the event said land is sold at private sale it shall first be valued by three disinterested free holders, who shall certify their findings as to value under oath to the County Court of the County before such sale is made.

But said land shall not be sold during my life except by my express consent in writing and if sold, shall be reinvested in accordance with my wishes as expressed in writing.

My said Trustee shall give bond in a sum not to exceed five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the faithful performance of this trust (unless in the event of sale of the land the said bond shall be in a sum equal to double the amount of the proceeds going to the beneficiary), which said bonds shall be filed with the Judge of the County Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and shall be governed by the rules and regulations prescribed by law in case of guardians and wards so far as making inventories and settlements with the beneficiary are concerned, and the said bond or bonds shall be subject to the approval of the Judge of the said Court.

This trust shall continue and be in full force and effect for the period of my natural life, and for the further period of the natural life of the said William Berryhill and on his death to his heirs or to such person or persons as he may designate by last will and testament, and shall be revocable in the event pardon should be granted me, and that my liberty should be restored, and in that event I shall have the right to be restored immediately to the possession of said property, and to demand an immediate settlement from the
