Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements, hereinafter made the party of the first part has this day and by these presents rented unto the party of the second party for agricultural purposes for the term of two years from and the 14th day of January 1911, the following described tract of land, the S. 24 of section 14, township 19 north and range 13 east, in Tulsa County, Okla.
