The Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian Territory.  
Do all to whom these presents shall come, Enacting:

Whereas, a townsite commission, heretofore appointed and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stat. 861) agree-  
ment ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901,  
has appraised the lots in the town of Chulsa,  
Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian Territory; and

Whereas the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 11th day  
of April 1902, and was duly placed on file and

Whereas, said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior and

Whereas, the said commission has awarded the real estate described herein below to Lillie G. Cropper who has paid eleven (\$11.00) dollars the full amount of the purchase price, into the Treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians with the United States Indian Agent at Muskogee Indian Territory, and in therefor, entitled to a patent;

Now, therefore, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek Nation) do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me of the above said Act of the Congress of the United States hereby grant and convey unto the said Lillie G. Cropper her heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, approved in and to Lot numbered (3) in block numbered (27) in the Town of Chulsa Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian Territory, and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

In witness whereof, I the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of said nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
