Whereas a townsite commission heretofore
appointed and acting under authority of the Act of
Congress approved March 1, 1901 (Stat. 861) agree-
ment ratified by the Creek Nation, may 25, 1901,
has appraised the lots in the town of Tulsa,
Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory; and

Whereas the plat of said town was approved
by the Secretary of the Interior on the 11th day of
April 1902 and was duly placed on file; and

all of the townsite included in said plat at
