#### General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture made this ninth day of March A.D. 1908, between James D. Capron, Junior, a single man of the City of St. Louis, in the State of Missouri, party of the first part, and George W. Lindsay of Circleville, Ohio, party of the second part.

all of lots ten (10) and eleven (11) in block thirty nine (39) of West Tulsa Addition, a subdivision of the east half of the north west quarter of section fourteen township nineteen, north, range twelve east according to the amended plat thereof, recorded in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court, and its Office's recorder of Tulsa, Indian Territory in book 2 at page 639.

To have and to hold the same together with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging to in any wise appertaining forever.
