

Legal of Eschschitz

The Undersigned, made this 3rd day of July 1905, the
and between Emily M. Campbell of Tucker County, the
Tucker, State of Oklahoma, opening of that will and testimony
of William Emory Campbell, deceased, of the first part, and one
J. H. Hume of Tucker, Tucker County, State of Oklahoma, of
the second part.

It is recited that whereas, under the terms of the said last will
and testimony of the said William Emory Campbell, deceased,
which will having been admitted to probate in the County
Court of the County of Tucker, State of Oklahoma, on the 1st
day of December, 1904, there was given to the said opening
Emily M. Campbell, to dispose of, in such a manner and
amount to her, nothing any and all real estate, decedent's debt
against it, and to sell and convey the same to, grant and
confer, her heirs, assigns, and

Thereas, on the 22nd day of January, 1905, said land
being so described and conveyed, was duly approved,
according to the statute in such case made and
provided, and the value of said land found upon
appraisalment by the appraisers thereof to be the same as shown
on appeal from the duly filed and approved return
of said appraisers on file in the County Court of
Tucker County, State of Oklahoma, and
whereas, on that day of May, 1905, the said decedent,
acting under the authority given her by said last will
and the statute of Oklahoma, in and case
made and provided, did said land having the
described as private and to remain if a woman for the
sum of \$500, said sum being more than 50% of the
appraised value thereof, and she gave and gave them
above specified being otherwise, and

Whereas, said decedent, filed her return of said will and
all proceedings had therein on the 5th day of June, 1905,
in the County Court of Tucker County, State of
Oklahoma, and

Whereas, pursuant to an order made by the said County
Court of Tucker on the 5th day of June, 1905, and the
statute of Oklahoma in such case made and
provided, there was filed in the Tucker County
