

Oklahoma Assignment of Mortgage.

Know all Men By these Presents, that The Deming Investment Company, (a corporation), of Oswego, Kansas, in consideration of the sum of twenty five hundred ^{no}/₁₀₀ Dollars, to it in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby sell assign transfer set over and convey unto Robert Y. Kay, his heirs and assigns, one certain mortgage, dated the 10th day of October A.D. 1908, executed by E. Stewart and Mary A. Stewart, husband and wife, to The Deming Investment Company, upon the following described property, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Beginning twenty five (25) feet east of the northwest corner of Lot one (1) in block one hundred nineteen (119) official plat, Tulsa, thence at right angles with third street in a southerly direction and parallel with the alley, one hundred (100) feet, thence at right angles in an easterly direction twenty five (25) feet, thence at right angles in a northerly direction to third street, thence at right angles in a westerly direction along third street to place of beginning. The same being a plot of ground 25 x 100 feet deep, and being a part of Lots one (1) and two (2) in said block one hundred nineteen (119), excepting always ten (10) feet of ground on the rear or south end of said lot, and all that part of Lot two (2), which is herein conveyed, which shall forever remain open for an alley or to be used as a driveway for the use of the premises given to secure the payment of \$2500.00 and the interest thereon and duly filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma and recorded in book 37, page 473 on the 21st day of October, 1908, together with note, debt and claim secured by said mortgage, and the covenants contained in said mortgage.
