

Release of Quit Claim

This Indenture, made and acted into this 7th day of January, 1909, by and between Hayward Hayden, party of the first part and Mattie B. Ingram, party of the second part,

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, (\$1500.00) cash in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, party of the first part has released, remised and quitclaimed, and does hereby release, remise and quitclaim unto the second party, all the following described premises and property, to-wit:

The southeast 1/4 of the northeast quarter of section twelve in township 1 north, range 10 west, in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, now Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and partitioned, releasing and quitclaiming unto said second party all the rights and interests and term, granted to first party by the certain rental contract entered into between the parties hereto and recorded at 3 o'clock P.M. on November 15th 1907, in records at page 584, in the office of the Deputy U.S. Clerk and recorder at Tulsa, Indian Territory, State of Oklahoma.
