In Consideration Of Twenty Five ^{no} 700 dollars this day paid to Jennie E. Broderick & her band S. W. Brown by The Gulf Pipe Line Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto said Gulf Pipe Line Company, its successors and assigns the right to locate, maintain and operate a pipe line for the purpose of conveyance of oil over, through and upon that certain tract of land situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and thus described: S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, T. 18, R. 12 E., a distance of about 80 rods.

Also there is hereby granted a right to erect and maintain a telephoned telegraph line. The rights herein granted shall permit the use of such land as may be necessary for said pipe line for said telegraph and telephone line, and shall also permit the grantee herein its successors and assigns to do whatever may be necessary to their construction or for the enjoyment of the rights herein granted including the right of ingress and egress to and from said tract of land for the purpose of laying, maintaining, repairing and restoring of said pipe line and said telegraph and telephone line, and for removing of same when desired by the grantee its successors and assigns.

To have and to hold the said easement unto the said Gulf Pipe Line Company, its successors and
