That I, Alta M. Yorkum, for and in consideration of the sum of thirty six Dollars to me cash in hand paid by E. H. Melhorn and for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and ninety eight and 6/100 Dollars to me cash in hand heretofore paid by W. F. Jones, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, quit claim and release unto the said W. F. Jones, and unto his heirs and assigns forever the following real estate situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot four and five and thereout one hundred feet of lot six in block fifty one and lot six in block forty six, all in the City of Tulsa, according to the government plat thereof. This deed is made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated July 24, 1903, and executed to the said Alta M. Yorkum by the said W. F. Jones to secure the payment of a certain promissory note therein described which said note has been fully paid and which said mortgage was duly recorded in book B, Page 291 in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court for the Western District of the Indian Territory and Ex-Officio Recorder at Sapulpa.
