Oklahoma, and was at the time herein after mentioned
and is now a duly qualified and acting Notary Public,

That on the 5th day of January, 1907, the said affiant
was present when L. B. Bowles paid me certain
note, dated June 15th, 1906, for the sum of \$153.00, in
