of Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, and

the Secretary of the Interior on the 26th day of March

the town lots included in said lot of this town
and extending improvements which have been approved
of the Secretary of the Interior, and
Whereas the said commission has approved
the real estate described herein filed to said Secretary
who has paid sum of (\$7000) dollars, the good amount
of the purchase price, into the treasury of the United
States, to the credit of the Cherokee Nation of Indians,
with the United States Indian Agent at Muscogee,
Indian Territory, and in therefore, entitled to a patent
New York, the undersigned, the Principal Chief
of the Cherokee Nation, do by virtue of the power and authority
vested in me by the aforesaid act of the Congress of the
United States, these grants, sell and convey unto the said
said Cherokee, the town and adjacent grounds, all the
right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, agreeing
in and to get numbered in Block number 15 in the town
of Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, and according
to the said act, as aforesaid, in the Cherokee Nation
at my hand and caused the great seal of said Nation
to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown. Date of issue
