

In the County Court and for Judicial County, State of Oklahoma.

Order approving Deed.

Now on this 2nd day of February 1909, is presented to the Court the Petition of Chas. Childers, Miller Childers, Tom Hopper and Lena Hopper and together filed herein praying the Court to approve the deed of conveyance dated on the 25th day of January, 1909, duly acknowledged and delivered and conveying to one W. B. Shultz for cash, the sum of twenty six hundred and eighty Dollars, all their right, title, interest and estate of the said Chas. Childers, Miller Childers, Lena Hopper and Tom Hopper, his heirs at law, of Quincy Childers, deceased, in and to the following described land, to-wit:

Southeast quarter (1/4) of section nineteen (19) township (19) north, range fourteen (14) east, Tarkenton county, State of Oklahoma, containing one hundred and eighty (180) acres, more or less.

And the Court having heard the evidence and considered the same, finds that the above named Chas. Childers, Miller Childers, Lena Hopper (see Childers) are ^{enrolled} on the full blood roll of the Creek Nation of the Five Civilized Tribes and that the above described lands were duly allotted by the Commission having charge of the allotment of lands to the Five Civilized Tribes; that the said Quincy Childers departed this life intestate on the 2nd day of September, 1904, that the said Quincy Childers left surviving her the following heirs: Chas. Childers, Miller Childers, Lena Hopper (see Childers) that they inherited the above described lands from their deceased child, Quincy that the said sum of Twenty six hundred and eighty Dollars is a fair price for said land and that the deed of said Chas. Childers and Miller Childers, Tom Hopper and Lena Hopper, now exhibited to the Court in conveying their interest in said lands to the said W. B. Shultz, ought to be approved.

It is therefore by the Court considered, ordered and adjudged and made a part of the record of this Court that the above mentioned Warranty Deed, which was duly executed by the ^{County} Chas. Childers and Miller Childers, Lena Hopper and Tom Hopper, on the 2nd day of February 1909,
