Order Concerning Sale.

Now on this the 1st day of February, 1909, this
matter came on for hearing upon the return of sale
made by John W. Bergman, as the guardian of
the said and estate of the said Lena Davis
and Nora Davis minors, and the said John W.
Bergman appearing in person and by the attorney,
Osgood & Brown, and the person or persons having
filed written exceptions or written objections to the
confirmation of said sale and no person or persons
appearing to make objections to the confirmation of
said sale and the Court after having examined said
return and having heard the evidence of witnesses
appeared in support of said return and listened to
the argument of counsel, and being fully advised
in the premises, finds:

That pursuant to a decree of sale heretofore made
and entered by this Court on the 29th day of December,
1908, the said John W. Bergman, as guardian of
said minors, did on the 1st day of January, 1909,
sell the respective interests of each of said minors to wit:
an undivided one third interest subject to the life
estate of Mrs. J. J. Person in and to the following de-
scribed real estate situate in Tulsa County, Okla-
homa to wit: 'The southeast quarter of the north
east quarter and the north half of the southeast
quarter and the east two-thirds of the west half
of the northeast quarter of Section 3, and the north
half of the northeast quarter of the southeast
quarter of Section 34 all in Township 19, north
Range 11, east, of Private sale to Charles Page and
H. C. Jones upon the following terms, to wit: 'For
the sum of \$300.00 payable as follows, to wit: 'For
That pursuant to the said decree of sale, heretofore
made on the said 29th day of December, 1908 and in
accordance with the Statute in such case made
