Hermon and unto his heirs and assigns forever the following lands lying in the City, Territory of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory in the S. one half of the S. quarter of the S. 6 quarter of section 1, Township 19 North Range 2 East, Tenth sec of block 159. I have and to hold the same unto the said granted W. J. Barker and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances therunto belonging. And hereby covenant with said granted Wm. W. Hermon that the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, will forever maintain and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand as Recorder of the Incorporated City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for and on behalf of said City and have hereunto affixed the Official seal of said City on this 17th day of October A.D., 1905.
