this mortgage shall stand as security in like manner and effect as for the payment of said principal debt, it being expressly agreed that in making such payments, the mortgages, its successors or assigns, shall be deemed acting as agent of the mortgager in every particular, and that payment by the said mortgages, its successors or assigns, of any such insurance premiums, taxes or assessments upon said property, or upon this mortgage, or the debt secured, judgement, mechanic's liens, or other statutory liens, or other claims, as hereinbefore provided, shall not be construed or be held to be a waiver of default in the terms of this mortgage, or prevent the holder hereof from declaring the entire debt secured hereby due and payable and foreclosing this mortgage, whether such payment be made prior or subsequent to the exercise of option to declare the debt due and foreclose this mortgage, as herein provoded.

Seventh: - It is further expressly agreed that if any default be made in the payment at the time and place and in the manner provided of all or any part of said debt or the interest thereon or, of any other sum hereby secured, or if raste shall be suffered or committed on said premises or if any mechanic's or other linns which maight be prior to the lien of this mortgage be created or rest upon said premises or any part thereof for ten days without the same being raid and discharge of said premises therefrom procured; or in case therefrom procure; or in case there shall exist upon said premises any claim, lien. encumbrances, easement or restriction prior to this mortgage, orif default be made in the payment of any installment of taxes or assessments upon said premises or upon the debt hereby secure.d, or the premiums for said insurance policies when the am same become due. or in event said there are is not at all times maintained as hereinbefore provided; or upon default in full preformance of each and every stipulation and covenant herein contain ed, the whole principal sum secured by this mortage, and interest thereon and all other amounts hereby secured shall at the option of the holder of this mortgage become immedistely due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed accordingly; and no demand for fullfillment of conditions broken nor notice of election to consider the debt due shall be necessary previous to commencement of suit to collect the debt hereby secured or any part thereof or to foreclose this mortgage; and in event suit is commenced to foreclose this mortrage, the mortragee, its successors or assigns shall be entitled to have a receiver appointed to take charge of said real estate during such litigation and period of redemption from sale thereunder, accounting to the mortgagor for the net income only, applying the same in payment of any part of the debt secured horeby remaining unpaid; and this morteage and notes secured hereby shall be in all respects construed according to the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

And it is further mutually covenanted and agreed that in the event of the passage, after the date of this mortgage, of any law of the State of Oklahoma, deducting from the value of land for the purposes of taxation any lien thereon, or changing in any way the 1 laws now in force for the taxation of mortgages or debt secured by mortgage for State or local purposes, or the manner of the collection of any such taxes, so as to affect this mortgage, the whole of the principal sum secured by this mortgage, together with the interest due thereon, shall, at the option of said party of the second part, without notice to any party, become immediately due and payable.

Bighth: In case of foreclosure hereof said mortragor hereby agrees to pay a sum equal to 10% of the amount due as attorney's fees in such foreclosure suit, to be secured by this mortgage which shall be due and payable when suit is filed and for the consideration above hereby expressly vaives the appraisement of said real estate and all benefits of the homestead and stay laws of said State.

Binth: - It is further agreed that in event any of the land hereinshove described is sought to be taken by virtue of the law of eminent domain or under the provision of

L'ALTE WA
