RIGHT OF WAY GRANT

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That C. L. Blankenship Adm., for Estate of W. M. Blankenship, (Dec'd) of the post office of Tulsa in the State of Okla for and in consideration of Forty and No/100 Dollars, cash in hand paid, receipt of wich is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey unto THE TEXAS PIPE LINE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA, a corporation of Oklahoma the right to lay, operate and maintain a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas, the grantee selecting the route, upon, over and through the following described land, situated in the County of Tulsa, in the State of Oklahoma:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 25 Twp 21 N-Rge 12 E

Also the grantee at any and all reasonable times shall have the right of ingress to and egress from such pipe lines and may remove the same in whole or in part at will.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement unto said THE TEXAS PIPE LINE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA, its successors and assigns, so long as such structures are maintained.

And by the acceptance hereof the grantee agrees to bury such pipe lines so that they will not interfere with the cultivation of the land, and also to pay any and all damages to crops, fences and land which may be suffered from the construction, operation or maintenance of such pipe lines.

It is also understood and acknowledged by the grantor or grantors that the persons securing this grant is without authority to make any agreement in regard to the subject matter hereof which is not expressed herein and that no such agreement will be binding on the grantee.
