HOMESTEAD DEED. 13207 Cheroke Citizent, No. 32197

COMPARED THE CHEROKEE NATION,

INDIAN TERRITORY

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS STALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas, By the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat.,716), ratified by the Cherokee Nation August 7, 1902, it was provided that there should be allotted, by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes, to each citizen of the Cherokee Nation, land equal in value to one hundred and ten acres of the average allotable lands of the Cherokee Nation; and

Wher as, It was provided by said act of Congress that each member of said tribe shall, at the time of the selection of his allotment, designate, or have selected and designated for him, from his allotment, land equal in value to forty acres of the average allotable 1 ands of the Cherokee Nation, as nearly as may be, as a homestead, for which separate certificate shall issue; and

WHEREAS, The said Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes has certified that the land hereinafter described has been selected by or on behalf of Alice Chisholm, a citizen of said tribe, as a homestead;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid act of the Congress of the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Alice Chisholm all right, title, and interest of the Cherokee Nation, and of all other citizens of said mation, in and to the following described land, viz: The East Half of the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter and the South West Guarter of the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Twenty-two (22) North and Range Fourteen (14) of the Indian Base and meridian, in Indian Territory, containing thirty (30) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to the conditions, provided by said act of Congress pertaining to allotted homestead.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed this 17th day of July, A.D., 1906
