WARRANTY DEED

NOW, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (500.00) Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and also for the further consideration of the agreement between the carties hereto, for themselves, their, heirs, successors and legal representatives, that intoxicating liquors shall never be manufactured, sola or otherwise disposed of, as a beverage, in any place of public resort, in and upon the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, and the express reservation to the Seller, his heirs and assigns, that in case that any of the conditions concerning intoxicating liquors are broken by the Purchaser, his heirs, successors, assigns, or legal representatives, then this deed shall become null and void and all right, title and interest in and to the premises hereby corveyed, shall revert to the soid Sand Springs Home, its successors and assigns, and the Purchaser, by accepting this deed for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, concent and agrees to this reservation and condition, as well as to the reser-
