GRANT OF SEPULTURE

which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, and sell unto the said C.H. Overton,
and unto his heirs and assigns so long as said lands are used as a cemetery by said city,
the sepulture Right to the following lands lying in the City Cemetery of the said City
of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in the south one-half of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter
of Section one (1), Township nineteen (19) North, Range twelve (12) East, to-wit:

West 1/2 of Block 306

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said grantee and unto his heirs and assigns, for
sepulture so long as said lands are used as a cemetery by said City of Tulsa.

And hereby covenant with said grantee C. H. Overton that the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
will warrant and defend the estate herein conveyed against all claims whatsoever.
