ORDINANCE NO. 1924

An Ordinance vacating ten feet on both sides of Trenton Avenue from the South line of Eleventh Street to the north line of Clark's Addition located in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof; and declaring an emergency, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That ten (10) feet on both sides of Trenton Avenue from the South line of Eleventh Street to the north line of Clark's Addition in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof, be, and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public street of said City.
