Second: That he will pay to said second part, or order, Four Thousand andno/100 DOL-Lars with interest thereon from April 25th, 1923 until paid, at the rate of eight per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the 25th day of October and April in each year, in accordance with one certain promissory note, of the said first part, due April 25th d926, with interest coupons attached of even date herewith.

Third: That during the continuance in force of this instrument, the said first party will pay all taxes, charges, assessments, rights or impositions, general or special, whether municipal, county, state or federal, that may be levied upon said real estate, when the same shall become by law, due and payable, and that first party will exhibit once a year, on demand, receipts of the proper persons, to said party of the secondpart, his heirs, executors administrators or assigns showing payment thereof, until the indebtedness hereby secured sha shall be fully paid, The said first party further agrees to constantly keep the said premises free from mechanic's liens and all other liens, and to preserve and protect the see curity hereunder against any adverse, superior or intervening claim or interest.

Fourth: That said first part will keep all buildings, fences, side-walks and other improvements on said real estate, in as good repair and condition as the same are in at the date, and permit no waste; that he will at no time permit any part of the premises to be used in the conduct of any illegal or disreputable business, or such as will tend to injure or unfit said premises for general business or residence purposes; that he will permit no unnecessary accumulation of combustible material upon said premises; that he will constantly keep in proper order all pipes, connections, fixtures and attachements of every kind relating to the plumbing for the use of natural or manufactured gas or both, water supply and sewerage, furnace, steam pipes and boilers so as to prevent damage or undue risk to the property thoreby, and will keep all electric light wires and connection in safe condition and properly insualted; the party of the seend part reserving for himself and his representatives, the right to enter upon and inspect the premises at any reasonable hours and as often as he, or they, may desire.

Fifth: That said first part will, at once, insure the buldings upon said premises against loss by fire, lightning and windstorms, to the amount of \$4000.00 in insurance companies approved by said second party, and at once deliver all policies, properly assigned, to said second party as collateral and additi nal security for the payment of said debt, interest, and all sums secured hereby, and will so maintain such insurance until said bebt is paid, and if default is made therein, then said second party may so insure and re-insure said buildings, acting as agent for said first part in every particular; that every insurance 🌬 policy on said premises, issued before said debt is paid, shall be assigned as collateral security to the party of the second part, or assigns, as above provided, and whether the same have been actually assigned or not, they shall, in case of loss be payable to said second party, or assigns, to the extent of their interest as mortgagee in said premises; and that said second party or assigns may assign said policies as agent of said first party to any subsequent purchaser of said premises; and that in the event of loss under such policy or policies, the second party shall have and is hereby specifically given full power to settle and collect the same and to apply the amount so collected toward the payment of the indebtedness hereby secured.

Sixth: That in case thesaid first part shall make default in any one or more of said agreements, then the said second party, or assigns, may pay such taxes, charges, assessments rights or imposition and effect such insurance, and protect said title against adverse eaclaims and liens, and payall costs thereof, and the amounts so expended therefor, with interest at the rate of ten per cent on sums paid for insurance and protection of title, and to release liens, and for costs thereof, from date of such expenditure until paid, and with

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
