ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, under date of July 25th, 1913, C. M. Downing, W. B. Frederick, Jay Stevenson and H. W. Randolph, as the owners of that certain tract or parcel of real property situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma described as -

East, containing 20 acres more or less.

entered into a certain contract with P. J. White and H. F. Sinclair whereby the said P. J. White and H. F. Sinclair for a consideration named in the contract, were authorized to go upon said premises for the purpose of mining and operating the same for oil and gas and of laying the pipe lines, building tanks, powers, stations and structures to take care of said products, and;

WHEREAS, as a further consideration for the rights granted the said P. J. White and H. F. Sinclair it was provided that the said C. M. Downing, W. B. Frederick, Jay Stevenson, and H. W. Randolph should each receive one-eighth (1/8th) of the net proceeds derived from the operation of said premises for oil and gas mining purposes, and;

WHEREAS, said contract contained other provisions with reference to the operation of said premises for said purposes and the interest of the parties therein, which said contract was duly filed for record on July 30th, 1913, and is shown by record in Book 158 at Page 19 of the records in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and;

WHEREAS, under date of October 3, 1913, C. M. Downing, by his instrument in writing of that date, duly executed, acknowledged and delivered, sold, assigned, transferred and conveyed unto the First National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, all of his right and interest in and to the afore described contract of July 25th, 1913, and;

WHEREAS, the said C. M. Downing was thereafter duly adjudged a bankrupt by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma, and in said proceeding B. C. Connor was duly appointed as Trustee of the bankrupt estate, and;

WHEREAS, by order of said court made and entered in said matter on the second day of December 1915, the said Trustee was duly authorized and directed to sell all of the right, title, interest and estate of said bankrupt in and to the real estate first above described and pursuant to said authority and direction, the said Trustee did sell and convey all of said interest in said property to H. B. Frederick by the deed of said Trustee duly executed acknowledged and delivered, which said deed was duly filed for record in the office of the County Clerk in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and recorded in Book 202, at Page 222 of the records of said office and;

WHEREAS, by the conveyances aforesaid the said First National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and H. B. Frederick are now the owners and holders of all of the right and interest of C.M.
