FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF Forty-eight and no/100(\$48.00) Dollars to me in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Y. E. Dunn does hereby grant to the OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and erect, maintain and operate a telegraph or telephone line, if the same shall be found necessary, on, over and through the following lands, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma described as follows, to-wit

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 13, Township 17, Range 12

with ingress and egress to and from the same. The said grantor, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe line; said damage, if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, heirs or assigns, one by the OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive. And it is hereby further agreed that the said OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of its pipes, the damage, if any, in making such change to be paid by the said OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY-----
