with ingress and egress to and from the same. And it is hereby further agreed that the said OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors or assigns may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of its pipes, the damage, if any, in making such change to be paid by the said OKLAHOMA PIPE LINE COMPANY-----
