in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances, that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgements, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature and kind soever except any taxes or assessments due and payable after Jan. 1, 1918, that it will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, its haeirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.

It is further agreed and stipulated that this conveyance is made subject to the following conditions and stipulations;

- (1) That neither the party of the second part, nor their heirs, executors, administrated or or assigns, or any person claiming under him, shall ever sell or rent said property or any part thereof to a negor or any person of African descent; but this provision shall not he construed to prohibit the erection and use of such servant house or houses thereon as shall be necessary to be used in connection with any residence erected on said premises for white persons.
- (2) Should the party of the second part their heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, or any person claiming under them violate any of the provisions hereof, the title to said property shall revert to and revest in the party of the first part.
