the petition in foreclosure the holder hereof shall be entitled to a Receiver, to the appointment of which the mortgagors hereby consent, when appointment may be made either before or after the decree of foreclosure; and the holder hereof shall in no case be held to account for any rental or damage other than for rents actually received; and the appraisement of said premises is hereby expressly waived, and all the covenants and agreements herein contained shall run with the land herein conveyed.
