D. 1920, and recorded in record 303 at page 371 of the records of said County Clerk, and made between Tate Brady Realty Company, a Corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the party of the first part, the land herein conveyed, with other land, was conveyed to the said party of the first part in trust for the uses and purposes in said indenture declared, and with rower of sale as therein set forth; said indenture dated the 28th day of June A. D.1919, is hereby referred to and made a part hereof, as if written out herein in full.

Said Trustee on behalf of Tato Brady Realty Company, a Corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the owner of the beneficial interest in said real estate at the time of the execution of this deed, as is shown by said indenture made on the 28th day of June A. D. 1919 and filed for record on the 22nd day of June A. D. 1920, and recorded in Record 303 at page 371 of the records of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahova, but not on behalf of itself, and by virtue of the power and authority here in granted covenants and agrees with the party of the second part as follows, to-wit:
