QUITCLAIM DEED

WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seventy Five & No/100, (\$75) DOLLARS to him in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quitclaim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part all his right, title, interest, estate, and every claim and demand, both at law and in equity, in and to all the following described property, to-wit:

All of Lot Numbered Six (6), in Block Numbered Seventeen (17), in town of Collinsville Oklahoma, as shown by the recorded plat thereof,

This is not now and never has been any portion of the Homestead of the Grantor herein, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said J. H. Maschal, his heirs and assigns forever, so that neither, the said Leon Levy or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and everyone of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
