222871 C. J. REAL ESTATE SECOND MORTGAGE COMPARED

THIS MORTGAGE, Made this 21st day of February A. D. 1923, by and between Benjamin H. May and Mary May, his wife of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, in the State of Oklahoma, as parties of the first part( hereinafter called mortgagors whether one or more), and EXCHANGE TRUST COMPANY, a corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma as the party of the second part ( hereinafter called mortgagees):

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, for the purpose of securing the payment of the sum of Twenty-five thousand & No/100 DOLLARS, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and also the interest thereon, as hereinafter set forth, do by these presents mortgage unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in Tulsa county and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northerly twenty-five (25) feet of Lot Six (6), and the southerly twenty-five (25) feet of Lot Seven (7), in Block One Hundred Forty-eight (148),

of the City of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat of said City, comprising a rectangular shaped piece of land having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on Main Street, by a depth of One Hundred Forty (140) feet to an alley and more particularly described as follows:
