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SEVENTH. It is further agreed by and between the parties here to that should drilling be commenced upon said premises at any time for oil or gas, or mining operations be
commenced upon said premises, whether by shaft mining, stripping or any other process
for the purpose of removing from said land any coal, minerals, stone or other substances
of my character whatsoever, such drilling or mining shall operate to make the debt which
this mortgage secures, payable upon demand, and second party here to shall be entitled to
demand and receive from the first part their full payment of said mortgage debt at any
time he(said second part---) may demand such payment; and in the event first party fails
to pay said debt immediately upon such demand being made, then the second party shall be
entitled to enforce the payment of such debt by action to foreclose this mortgage the same as
if first party had defaulted in the parformance of all the other provisions hereof resting
upon them to do.

And the saidparties of the first part, forthe said consideration do hereby expressly waive appraisement of said real estate, and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.

The foregoing conditions being performed, this conveyance to be void; otherwise of full force and virtue.
