Boyle and Van Leigh Boyle for their heirs, executors, or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature or kind soever except taxes falling due after this date and that they WILL WARRANT AND FOREVER DEFEND THE SAME unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs, administrators, assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same. All special assessment taxes shall be paid by the party of the second part.
