GUARDIAN'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 25rd day of February 193----, at Tulsa, Tulsa county, state of Oklahoma, by and between Henry Watkins, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Guardian of Robert Watkins, minor and F. T. Saddler, the party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That Whereas, on the 23 day of November, 191---, the County court within and for the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, made an Order of Sale, authorizing the said party of the first part to sell certain real estate of the said Robert Watkins situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, described in said order of sale

AND WHEREAS Under and by virtue of said Order of Sale and pursuant to legal notices given thereof, the said party of the first part, on the 2nd day of May 1922, A.
