## POSTPONEMENT OF LIEN

Amongst the Records of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

Agreement to Postpone the Lien on the following in-part recited Mortgage.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Board of Home Missions and Church Extension (formerly the Board of Church Extension) of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to it in hand paid by the First Methodist Episcopal Church of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has covenanted, promised and agreed, and does hereby for itself, its successors and assigns, covenant, promise and agree with the said the First Methodist Episcopal Church of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, its successors and assigns, that the Mortgage dated February 15, 1905, for Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars, and recorded February 20th 1905, in book No. 14 M. of Mortgages, page 366, also the Mortgage dated August 19th 1920 for Six Thousand (\$6,000) Dollars, and recorded September 2nd 1920, in Book No. 304 of Mortgages, page 502, shall be postponed in favor of and made subsequent to a lien of a certain Mortgage given and executed by the above named First Methodist Episcopal Church of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, to The Farm and Home Savings Association to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Thousand, Five Hundred (\$15,500) Dollars, covering the following described real estate, lying and being situate in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma to wit:

Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), Block Thirty-one (31), Town of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

And it is hereby agreed that the said Postponement of Lien shall have the same force and effect as if the above-in-part recited Mortgage, or Mortgages, in favor of the Board of Home Missions and Church Extension of the Methodist Episcopal Church has been entered upon the records in the office for the recording of Deeds, etc., of Tulsa County aforesaid, on a day subsequent to the day of entry for record in the office aforesaid of the said Mortgage for the sum of Fifteen Thousand <sup>Five Hundred</sup> (\$15,500) Dollars,
