( Oklahoma Form of Deed to Trustees of Methodist Episcopal Church.)

This Indenture, Made this 19th day of February A. D. 1923 between George Ash, L. C. Reynolds, E. T. Neihling, A. H. Bynum, J. D. Walker C. A. Waid , W. P. Fraker, W. C. Showman, Dr. W. D. Ownby, U. B. Mader and P. M. Thomas as trustees of the First Methodist Episcopal Church of Broken Arrow Okla. of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma of the first part, and Methodist Episcopal Church of Broken Arrow Oklahoma ( A corporation) party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said parties of the first part do, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of the following described real estate situated in the county of Tulsa, state of Oklahoma, to-wit: All of Lots Numbered Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), and Twelve (12), in Block Number thirty one (31), in the original town or city of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, according to the official plat and survey thereof, and all improvements thereon.
