Drake of Warrensburg, Missouri, to have been one and the same person as Mrs. Pet Baile Drake, and was well acquainted with her and knows of his own knowledge that on September 15, 1916, a mortgage was given to Mrs. W. L. Drake by E. E. Baile, Jr. and Marie Baile, his wife, for six hundred dollars (\$600.00) on the following described property:
