RENT CONTRACT

This contract made and entered into this the 2nd day of April, 1923, by and between F. M. Campbell----- and Rosa Campbell/^{Owasso,} Oklahoma, party of the first part and J. A. Shadrick, party of the second part, said contract in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

For and in consideration of the sum of \$110.00, party of the first part has this day rented to party of the second part all of that part of the land laying on the south side of Bird Creek and located in the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 4, Township 20, Range 13 east, same being all of the broke and improved land on said forty acres, for the term of two years beginning the first of January, 1923 and ending the last day of December, 1925. It is agreed that the full amount of \$110.00 has been paid in cash this day.

It is understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the said land is to be farmed by party of the second part for the full period of two years and that said contract shall terminate on the 31st day of January, 1925, without further notice to either party unless the same is extended in writing prior to that date.
