QUIT CLAIM DEED

COMPARED

has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do for them-
selves heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all our right, title,
interest, estate ----- claim and demand both at law and equity in and to the following des-
cribed property, to-wit:

All of the East one-half (1/2) of the North One Hundred Forty-five
(145') feet of Kerr Street adjoining Lot One (1) in Block One (1)
Pomeroy Heights Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
according to the recorded plat thereof

Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said William
