shown of record in Book 312, at page 222 of the title records of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in which the grantees were M.M. Travis and S. R. Travis. Mult by instrument dated the 4th day of Apirl, 1921, recorded in Book 363, at page 266 of the title records of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, I, joined by my wife, Julia Travis, deeded an undivided one-half interest in the lands above described to Rhea Travis, Trustee, That the Rhea Travis, named as grantee in said deed, is the wife of M. That Julia Travis, my wife, who signed the deed last above mentioned with me, had no part in the transaction, and simply signed the deed to satisfy any requirement as to conveyance of an interest in the homestead, if any homestead rights should have attached to said land thereby conveyed.
