

## COMPARED

continuing on the aforesaid course a distance of Three Hundred (300) feet to a point; thence South Sixty-seven degrees (67 ) no Minutes (0') West, a distance of Seven Hundred Twelve and Nine-tenths (712.9) feet to a point; thence South Thirty-four degrees (34 ) Thirty-eight minutes (38') West, a distance of Two Hundred and Eighty-eight (288) feet to a point; thence South Fifty-five degrees (55 ) Twenty-two minutes (22') East, a distance of Five Hundred Twenty-six and Six-tenths (526.6) feet to a point; thence North Thirty-four degrees (34 ) Thirty-eight minutes (38') East, a distance of Two Hundred Eight and Six-tenths (208.6) feet to a point; thence North Sixty degrees (60 ) Four minutes (4') East, a distance of Four Hundred Ninety-five and Eight-tenths (495.8) feet to a point of curve to the left with a radius of Two Hundred Seventy-two and Nine-tenths (272.9) feet, a distance of Two Hundred Eighty-two and Eight-tenths (282.8) feet to a point, thence North no degrees (0 ) Fourteen Minutes (14') East, a distance of One Hundred Sixty and Two-tenths (160.2) feet; containing in all Eleven and One Hundred Fifty-eight Thousandths (11.158) Acres, more or less.

12. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, situate in the City of Derby, County of New Haven and State of Connecticut, and known and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the Northerly line of land now or formerly of Merritt-Clark, Twenty (20) feet Westerly from the Westerly line of New Haven Avenue, thence continuing Westerly in the aforesaid Northerly line of land now or formerly of Merritt-Clark a distance One hundred Two (102) feet Six (6) inches, more or less, to the Easterly right-of-way line of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company; thence Northwesterly along said right-of-way line a distance of One hundred one (101) feet more or less to the Southerly line of Gilbert Street; thence Northeasterly along said street line a distance of Fifty-four (54) feet Six (6) inches, more or less, to a point; thence Easterly along the Southerly line of Gilbert Street, but forming an interior angle of One hundred Sixty-four (164) degrees with last described street line, a distance of Four and Thirty-four hundredths (4.34) feet to a point; thence Southeasterly on a curved line convex to the Northeast, having a radius of One hundred Ninety-six (196) feet, a distance of One hundred nine (109) feet more or less to the point of beginning, in the aforesaid North line of Merritt-Clark as aforesaid.
