23. BRANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lots--pieces--or parcels--of land, situate in the City of Bloomington, County of McLean, and State of Illinois, and known and described as follows, to wit:

Parcel #1. The West Thirty (30) feet of Lot Two (2) in Block one (1) in Loehr's First Addition to the City of Bloomington, and the East Thirteen (13) feet of Lot One (1) of Cox and Vaughn's Subdivision of Lot Three (3), Block One (1) in Loehr's First Addition to the City of Bloomington.

Parcel #2.
