37. RANCH HOUSE. All of the following described lots, pieces or parcels of land, situate in the City of Evanston, County of Cook and State of Illinois, and known and described as follows, to wit:

The South One Hundred and Twenty (120) feet of Lots Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Eighteen (18), except the West Thirty-three (33) feet of Lot Eight (8), in the City of Evanston in said County and State, together with all the trackage rights of the grantors appurtenant to said property.
