45, *Packaging Plant*; all of the following described lots *pieces*
land, ^{or parcels of land} situate in the City of Indianapolis, County of Marion, and State of

Beginning at a point in a line which is the middle line of Wyoming Street in the City of Indianapolis, projected westerly at a point distant Six Hundred Twenty-nine (629) feet West of the West line of West Street in said City, and running thence South, parallel with said West Street Three Hundred Fifty-two (352) feet to a point; thence East, parallel with said projected middle line of Wyoming Street Thirty-four (34) feet; thence Eastward Forty (40) feet to a point distant Three Hundred Forty-four and Four-tenths (344.4) feet South of said projected middle line of Wyoming Street; thence Eastward Thirty-six (36) feet to a point distant Three Hundred Twenty-nine (329) feet South of said projected middle line of Wyoming Street; thence Eastward Fifty-five (55) feet, to a point in the middle line of the railway track known as the Vandalia Switch or the Starch Works branch of the Vandalia Railroad Company, at a point distant Three Hundred Three and Three-tenths (303.3) feet South of said projected middle line of Wyoming Street; thence Southwestwardly along and with the middle line of said Vandalia Switch One Hundred Forty-five and Nine-tenths (145.9) feet to a point in the West line of Lot Eighty (80) in Simon Yandes' Subdivision of a portion of Out-lot One Hundred Twenty-nine (129) of the Donation Lands of the City of Indianapolis, distant Eleven and Two-tenths (11.2) feet Northeastwardly from the Southwest Corner of said Lot Eighty (80) aforesaid; thence Southwestwardly Three Hundred Thirty-eight and Six-tenths (338.6) feet to the North line of Ray Street, in the City of Indianapolis, at a point distant One Hundred Seventy-three and seventy-five Hundredths (173.75) feet West of the West line of Dakota Street in said City; thence West along and with the North line of said Ray Street, Six Hundred Eighty-eight and Twenty-five Hundredths (688.25) feet, to a point in the line (in the middle of White River) established by deed of Nicholas McGarty and others to the Union Trust Company of Indianapolis, as Administrator de bonis non with the Will Annexed of the estate of Washington J. De Pauw, deceased, dated May 18, 1899, and recorded in Town Lot Record 314, Page 329, office of the Recorder of Marion County, Indiana; thence Northeastwardly along and with the said line so established by said deed (same being a straight line which, if projected, would strike the center point of the bridge over White River on Kentucky Avenue in Indianapolis), Five Hundred Thirty-seven (537) feet, more or less, to a point in the line which is the middle line of Wyoming Street in said City projected westwardly; thence Easterly and along with said projected middle line of Wyoming Street, Nine Hundred THIRTY-three and Six-tenths (933.6) feet, to the place beginning; containing Eleven and Forty-five Hundredths (11.45) acres, be the same more or less. Including all appurtenances, rights, covenants and accretions, thereto belonging.
